he Northwest Territories are one of the top places in the world to watch the Northern Lights. Unlike other northern destinations, the sea is far away, therefore it is a very arid area in general. What does this have to do with seeing the lights? The less humidity in the air, the more crisp and clear the nights. There are rarely continuous days of cloud coverage, which allows for open views of the skies. Each time we have spent one month and saw the lights on average 23 out of the 30 days!

#### Roberto Gibbons Gomez


